"numero 3 = tres" = number 3 = three

"ya tiene pendientes pequeños" = he already has small earrings

"he ido tres veces" = I have gone three times

"me encantó la cafetería" = I loved the cafeteria

"el café estaba buenísimo" = the coffee was excellent

"no he ido nunca" = I have never gone

"estaba decepcionaba DE no poder ir con vosotros" = I was disappointed not to be able to go with you

"estabas enferma" = you were sick

"no estoy acostumbrado al frío" = I'm not used to the cold

"tengo un poco de resfriado" = I have a bit of a cold

"te has recuperado Breda?" = have you recovered, Breda?

"CASI = almost" = ALMOST = almost

"Casi del todo" = almost completely

"todo casi todo el tiempo strepsils" = all almost all the time strepsils

"tienes que ir al sol" = you need to go to the sun

"es verdad - tienes que ir al sol" = it's true - you need to go to the sun

"hace sol aquí hoy" = it's sunny here today

"hace buen día" = it's a nice day

"por que eres positiva Terri," = why are you positive, Terri,

"no puede ser peor (Worse)" = it can't be worse

"el domingo hacia un dia estupendo" = Sunday was a wonderful day

"recuerda que los irlandeses son fáciles de contentar" = remember that the Irish are easy to please

"fue una buena noche" = it was a good night

"para quedar con todos" = to meet with everyone

"conocer a gente en persona" = to meet people in person

"pasamos de un grupo a otro?" = did we move from one group to another?

"conociste a alguien diferente?" = did you meet someone different?

"la chica de Arklow - Aimee" = the girl from Arklow - Aimee

"Marie es de Wexford pero no la conocía" = Marie is from Wexford but I didn't know her

"es muy interesante porque MARie va a hacer un intercambio" = it's very interesting because Marie is going to do an exchange

"cerca de Barcelona -" = near Barcelona -

"va a hacer un intercambio de casa" = she is going to do a house exchange

"es gratis -" = it's free -

"no es por una agencia" = it's not through an agency

"también es bueno porque puedes estar de vacaciones" = it's also good because you can be on vacation

"en un lugar de tu eleccion" = in a place of your choice

"al mismo tiempo es una ventaja porque tu casa no está Vacía" = at the same time, it's an advantage because your house isn't empty

"soy muy maniático - me encanta el orden" = I am very particular - I love order

"no soporto tener muchas cosas en el suelo" = I can't stand having many things on the floor

"tienes alguna mania en casa?" = do you have any obsessions at home?

"es mejor vivir cuando las cosas están ordenadas" = it's better to live when things are organized

"de vez en cuando, hay muchas cosas en las sillas y en la mesa" = from time to time, there are many things on the chairs and the table

"me siento mal / no soporto verlas" = I feel bad / I can't stand seeing them

"voy a ordenarlo" = I will organize it

"es mas difícil pensar cuando la casa está desordenada" = it is more difficult to think when the house is disorganized

"estais de acuerdo?" = do you agree?

"no cabe duda = without a doubt" = NO DOUBT = without a doubt

"pienso que hay lugar para CADA COSA" = I think there is a place for EVERYTHING

"es mas fácil porque es mas fácil encontrar todo" = it is easier because it is easier to find everything

"no soy tan ordenada" = I am not as organized

"no soy tan perfeccionista como antes" = I am not as much of a perfectionist as

before

"soy mas relajada sobre el orden" = I am more relaxed about order

"antes cuando había alguien haciendo un trabajo en mi casa" = before when there was someone doing work in my house

"era mas perfeccionista" = I was more of a perfectionist

"ahora no" = not now

"está bien" = it's okay

"he cambiado desde que me jubilé" = I have changed since I retired

"ahora soy menos perfeccionista" = now I am less of a perfectionist
